Stand up and walk backward as far

The contents of your package should include: 1 x Frame 1 x Canopy 1 x Set of pegs (4 or 6) 1 x Set of guy ropes (4 or 6) 1 x Carry bag for unit

Lift black tag on corner of canopy and lift up approximately 10cm. Two options to lock roof system in place.

Ontion 1.

Place left hand on corner and push down. Place right elbow into hip and right hand on strut and push up. Push up until slider bracket locks on spring button.

Remove Quikshade from packaging and stand vertically with feet on the ground. Stand either side of the Quikshade. Place right hand on outside right leg, left hand on outside left leg.

Both step back together holding outside legs, open arms to approximately 1m (or as far as you can). Remove canopy from package and toss over frame. Place corners of canopy over corner sections of frame and fix to press studs. Adjust canopy so peak is over centre pole. Your unit is now ready to erect.

Stand in centre of product and reach down to lower 'v' struts at each end and hold firmly.





Option 2.

Turn side hip into product. Put right hip next to leg of frame. Bring right arm over cover and together with left hand on opposite strut, lift together. Spring button will click into place





Put your foot on base plate. With straight back, bend knees and grip middle of leg and lift until the spring button clicks or locks into place.





The height can be adjusted at three levels to suit your needs.

Assembly completed.

- **1.** Transportation and storage of product is best suited in upright position.
- 2. Do not place objects on top of unit when transporting or storing.
- **3.** Do not drag or slide the collapsed Quikshade on the cover end.

4. When transporting, do not allow unit to rub against other items as this may damage the cover.

5. If you are unable to transport in an upright position. Either remove canopy to avoid rubbing from frame or lie down and place padding (piece of carpet) under product or you can purchase a padded bag.



Assembly Instructions

TIE DOWN PROCEDURE

Never use your Quikshade without tying it down, and never leave your Quikshade unattended or up overnight. Be Safe! Secure your investment at all times.







1 & 2. Lift black tag on corner of canopy and curl upwards and outwards, about 10cm. Thread guy rope around leg and thread through loop in rope.

3. Place peg in ground and tighten rope. Peg only needs to be 15cm-20cm away from leg. Pull canopy skirt back down over rope and corner post. Sandbags are recommended for added security.

TO PACK THE QUIKSHADE AWAY

Remove walls. Remove guy ropes and pegs from structure. Do not leave product at this point unattended, always be near or hold your product when not tied down. Leave cover on frame. Release spring button in centre of leg and gently pull down. Repeat on all 4 legs. Undo Velcro on skirt.







- Lift black tag on corner of canopy and curl upwards and outwards, about 10cm.
- Go to centre of product and place hands firmly on top 'V' struts and together walk slowly towards each other. Watch your fingers!
- 3. Give Quikshade a cuddle and place carry bag over product.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

1. Single person assembly process. Walk to each corner post and pull product out as far as you can. Squeeze under Quikshade and lift centre pole and all four struts will ease up each leg.

2. To add wall.

Wrap Velcro around top or bottom assembly strut on roof of frame depending on the height you have your adjustable legs. Secure walls by wrapping Velcro to corner posts. Remember to put your 'wall peg' at base of wall.

3 & 4. To add additional leg.

Slide additional leg through hole in bottom of bracket. Press lower "v clip" in to allow additional leg to pass through to upper bracket. On completion the spring button should be exposed. Push lower foot of leg to extend post when spring button locks in position. Ensure this is at the same height of other legs.



STABILITY

1. Quikshade provide you with superior guy ropes and pegs to secure your product at all times. For extra stability we suggest sandbags (See Photo 3 in Tie Down Procedure). These sandbags hold approximately 12kg of dry sand.
